## **Establishment**

On February 12, 2007 (Ordinance No. 14,628) City Council established the Ingersoll Avenue Self-Supported Municipal Improvement District. The ordinance establishes the life of the district from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2022 which can be extended by the City Council an additional five years unless a petition of owners of not less than 40 percent of the valuation of the area is submitted opposing such an extension. The maximum rates are:

FY08 – FY12	\$1.75
FY13 – FY17	\$2.25
FY18 and thereafter	\$3.00

The fiscal year 2009 rate is \$1.75.

The combined operational and capital improvement fund provides financing for improvements consisting of improved sidewalks, curbs and cross-walks, landscaping, planters, decorative lighting, utility relocation, traffic signals, and related pedestrian improvements.
