



PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES PROVIDED IN OUR COMMUNITY ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF OUR CITIZENS' EVERYDAY LIVES; AND
- WHEREAS, THE SUPPORT OF AN UNDERSTANDING AND INFORMED CITIZENRY IS VITAL TO THE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF PUBLIC WORKS SERVICES AND MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS SUCH AS SANITATION, SEWERS, STREETS, FORESTRY, AND WASTEWATER RECLAMATION AND
- WHEREAS, THE PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF THE AREA'S NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE BENEFIT OF FUTURE GENERATIONS DEPENDS ON THESE SERVICES AND PROGRAMS; AND
- WHEREAS, THE QUALITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THESE FUNCTIONS, AS WELL AS THEIR PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION, IS VITALLY DEPENDENT UPON THE EFFORTS AND SKILL OF PUBLIC WORKS AND ENGINEERING OFFICIALS; AND
- WHEREAS, THE EFFICIENCY OF THE QUALIFIED AND DEDICATED PERSONNEL WHO STAFF THE PUBLIC WORKS AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS ARE MATERIALLY INFLUENCED BY THE PEOPLE'S ATTITUDE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THE WORK THEY PERFORM.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, T. M. FRANKLIN COWNIE, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 19 - 23, 2008, AS:

"NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK"
